

Bradley Woods Overall Considerations

- Pursue additional opportunities to protect rare lake plain forest and associated hydrology
- Partner to improve trail connections to neighborhoods and regional links to Rocky River Reservation and Lorain Metroparks - refer to Cuyahoga Greenways and NOACA's Regional Metroparks Connectivity Plan

Management Center

- Connect to city sewer system
- Stripe and sign service drive to allow use as an all purpose trail
- Link to Bailus Road, neighborhood to north, and Center Ridge Road

Quarry Rock Loop Trail

- Promote this existing high quality trail

Main Entrance and White Oak Lane

- Add crosswalk and connect existing all purpose trail along Bradley Road to interior of reservation utilizing segments of existing trail; add boardwalk in wet areas
- Incorporate traffic calming to help enforce vehicle speeds; consider speed tables
- Obtain street address for operations, transit, and emergency needs

Swamp Forest Area

- Continue resource management program

Crocker Road/Stearns Road Links

- Use sidewalk network to connect to Bailus Road and into park from the north
- Formalize existing natural surface trail

Codrington Shelterhouse

- Add crosswalk to connect to new trail along White Oak Lane
